Infectious or Biological Wastes
Latex Paint (can be solidified and included with bulk trash)
Medicines or Syringes
PCB's
Radioactive Materials
Smoke Detectors
Televisions, Monitors, Computer Components
Tires

Never Mix Chemicals

- Use original container, tighten caps and lids
- Sort and pack separately: oil paint, pesticides and household cleaners
- Pack in sturdy upright containers and pad with newspaper
- Do not place in garbage bags
- Never smoke while handling hazardous materials

We reserve the right to refuse unidentified material and large amounts of hazardous waste
