Lakeville's Tax classification hearing is set for Monday, November 25<sup>th</sup>. Harald Scheid is working on Lakeville's interim revaluation. Assessments started out at 88% assessment level, in the past always targeted assessments at 95%. First draft changes bring the assessment level to 92%. Harald Scheid will have to push the values up a little bit more. Big challenge: waterfront property still going up.

New Business: Reviewed an administrative abatement, filed due to a double assessment. Two bills went out for the same business. Christos Royal Pizza.

We have a parcel coming out of chapter, Chamberlin property on Highland Rd. Parcel lien release signed by the Board

Boat Excise bills have gone out. 2/3's never get paid, some we never hear from again. Suspending the boat excise tax until the states Environmental Police improve their process for tracking boat ownership and places of mooring might be considered by the BOA. BOA requested that this matter be put on the agenda for the next meeting.
