Regulations for Food Establishments with Drive-thrus

A. Purpose

Whereas the Lakeville Board of Health is responsible for inspecting food establishments within the Town of Lakeville, and must ensure compliance regarding trash/trash debris, concerns, violations, and complaints. The Lakeville Board of Health has adopted the following regulations:

Establishments that provide food drive-thru services must ensure trash/trash debris is controlled at all times.

B. Authority

This regulation is promulgated pursuant to the authority granted to the Lakeville Board of Health by Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 111, section 31 which states "Boards of Health may make reasonable health regulations".

C. Definition

A food establishment drive-thru (or drive-through) is a type of service provided by a business that allows customers to purchase products without leaving their cars.

D. Operating a fast food establishment drive-thru

- Each drive-thru food establishment must supply at least one trash container (durable and stable) in the drive-thru lane. The trash containers are to be changed daily or as needed so that they do not overflow and create a nuisance.
- Any trash/debris that is accumulated must be removed and disposed of properly.
- The drive-thru food establishment is also responsible for accumulation of trash/debris on the grounds.

E. Effective Date

This regulation shall be effective on: May 1st 2019

F. Violations

It shall be the responsibility of the food establishment, permit holder, and/or his or her designee to ensure compliance with this regulation.


G. Enforcement


Enforcement of this regulation shall be by the Lakeville Board of Health or its designated agent(s).

H. Severability

If any provision of this regulation is declared invalid or unenforceable, the other provisions shall not be affected thereby but shall continue in full force and effect.
