46 Shore Avenue41-1-1Thomas & Darleen Green

Discussion was held between Board members relative to the non-conforming septic system at 46 Shore Avenue. The Board of Health Office received notice that Thomas and Darleen Green purchased this property two years ago without a Title V inspection. Mrs. Green came in to apply for a permit to replace her shallow well, and on review of the office records, it was found that a septic plan was approved by the Board and the Department of Environmental Protection for a "tight tank" ten years ago, then revised and resubmitted in 2005 prior to the change of ownership. The previous owner Bruce Farrell never installed the "tight tank". Upon motion made by Member Garvey, seconded by Chairman Turcotte, the Board

VOTED: To send a letter to Thomas and Darleen Green requesting their presence at the next Board of Health meeting scheduled for June 4, 2008; to give just cause as to why this approved tight tank installation has not been started and completed at this property. Unanimous vote.

17 Heritage Hill Drive30-2-29Olde Stone Lookout, LLCDiscussion was held on the revised subsurface sewage disposal plans dated May 12, 2008from Prime Engineering, Inc. for Olde Stone Lookout, LLC at 17 Heritage Hill Drive.Board members discussed the manhole cleanouts for the maintenance barn. Upon motionmade by Member Garvey and seconded by Chairman Turcotte, the Board

VOTED: To approve the revised plans as submitted. Unanimous vote.

Discussion was held relative to the submittal of proposed sewage disposal plans from Brant S. Haworth Associates. Board members said the plans would be would be reviewed upon each submittal to make sure that all required information is provided on the application and plans.
