Old Business-Review and vote on Job Description for the Board of Selectmen Clerk

The Board reviewed the proposed Job Description for the new position of the Full Time Clerk in the Board of Selectmen's Office

Upon a motion made by Selectmen Powderly and seconded by Selectmen Hollenbeck, it was

VOTED: To approve the Job Description for the Board of Selectmen Clerk and to

authorize Selectmen Hollenbeck to finalize any changes with Labor

Counsel and the Town Administrator.

At 6:15 PM, the Board recessed and waited in the Mayor's Office until the Council was ready to meet with the Selectmen.

They also agreed to reimburse the Town of Lakeville the payments for FY15 and FY16 and to authorize the Mayor to file Special Legislation as required for the purchase of land in the Town of Lakeville.
