Selectmen's Meeting Minutes
August 20, 2010
2:00 PM

On August 20, 2010, the Board of Selectmen held a Special Meeting at the Town Offices. The Meeting was called to order at 2:00 PM. Present: Selectman Yeatts and Selectman Maksy.

Review Draft Warrant Article for Sysco

Selectman Yeatts stated the Board scheduled a Special Meeting in order to vote on the draft Warrant Article for Sysco so that the Planning Board had enough time to schedule a hearing for the zoning change for the upcoming Special Town Meeting

Upon a motion made by Selectman Maksy and with Chairman Yeatts stepping down to second and stepping back up to vote, the Board

VOTED: To send the Final Draft of the Warrant Article for Sysco as presented to the Planning Board so that they may schedule a Public Hearing.
Unanimous in favor.

The Board reviewed the revisions that were made since the last draft. A few questions were taken from the people attending the Meeting.

Other Business

The Board reviewed the request from Superintendent of Streets Chris Peck regarding the request from Celco Construction Corp. about the possibility of closing Montgomery Street during portions of the water main installation. The closure would be between Barstow Street and Precinct Street allowing for traffic to be detoured around Montgomery Street utilizing Barstow Street. Any road closure would be temporary between the hours of 8AM and 4 PM with the roadway being re-opened to general traffic prior to the evening commute.

Upon a motion made by Selectman Maksy and with Chairman Yeatts stepping down to second and stepping back up to vote, the Board

VOTED: To approve Celco's request to close Montgomery Street during the water main installation.
Unanimous in favor.
