Request for One Day All Alcohol Liquor License-Park Commission

New Business

The Board discussed the letter received from the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) regarding Lakeville's MS4 General Permit Annual Report for Year 8. Ms. Garbitt explained the original Permit was for five (5) years and expired on May 1, 2008 but was continued in effect for another two (2) years. The Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) discontinued their notification process for years six (6) and seven (7), so numerous communities throughout Massachusetts, including Lakeville, failed to file their Annual Reports for May 1, 2009 and May 1, 2010. The new MS4 General Permit was supposed to go into effect in August 2011, so Ms. Garbitt did not file the May 1, 2011 Annual Permit.

After further discussion, upon a motion made by Selectman Maksy; seconded by Selectman Belliveau, the Board:

VOTED: To issue a check in the amount of Six Thousand (\$6,000.00) to the Environmental

Protection Agency (EPA).
