TOWN OF LAKEVILLE Selectmen's Meeting Minutes December 20, 2007

On December 20, 2007, the Board of Selectmen held a Special Meeting at the Lakeville Library to attend the Appeals Board Meeting regarding Residences at LeBaron Hills. The meeting was called to order at 7:15 PM. Present were Selectman Yeatts, Selectman Evirs, and Selectman Maksy.

The Board reviewed the letter and plans received from Kenneth Motta, Field Engineering, regarding the two (2) alternatives for the closure of Route 79. Selectman Maksy recused himself from the discussion. Upon a motion made by Selectman Evirs and with Chair Yeatts stepping down to second and stepping back up to vote, the Board

VOTED: To recommend Plan A as the preferred method to dead end Route 79. Unanimous in favor.

There was discussion about forwarding both plans to the Middleboro Board of Selectmen and to make it very clear that Lakeville Selectmen were mandated by Mass Highway to produce these plans showing how Route 79 could be dead ended. Selectman Evirs would like to see Ken Motta present and explain the situation to the Middleboro Board of Selectman accompanied by a member of the Lakeville Board of Selectmen.

After attending the Appeals Board meeting regarding the Residences at LeBaron Hills, the meeting was adjourned at 8:40 PM.
