

Lakeville Cemetery Commission
Meeting Minutes
March 14, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 9:05 a.m. by Chairman Upham.

Members present: Commissioners Upham and Morton
absent: Commissioner Beal

Guests present: None

Minutes of the February 14, 2017 meeting were read and approved.

Old Business:

1. Water at Precinct Cemetery- Paul Gargiulo of the City of Taunton will check with the Commissioner of Plans and Development to see if a tie-in to the hydrant is possible.

New Business:

1. Rotten tree needs to come down at Ward Cemetery. The Highway Dept. can't take it down because it will need a climber. We need to have a private company do this work. Mockingbird Hill will be contacted to get an estimate.
2. Review proposals from South East Fence for repairs at:
 1. Ward Cemetery- \$1241.00 to repair and realign 12 granite posts and reset 1 post.
 2. Strobridge Cemetery- \$961.00 to replace 1 rod, repair posts and set 1 new granite post.
 3. Hafford Cemetery- \$1441.00 to remove and replace 25 steel rods and straighten posts.

A letter from Commissioner Beal dated 3-10-17 to the Commission stated that he agrees to the work at Ward and Strobridge and prefers to remove and replace the rods and straighten the posts at Hafford.

A motion was made by Chairman Upham and seconded by Commissioner Morton to replace and repair the rods and posts at Hafford and to approve the proposals for the work at Ward and Strobridge. Chairman Upham will fax the approval to South East Fence.

3. Spring Project- Repairs to McCully Cemetery. We spoke with Building Inspector Darling re the broken posts from the construction of a new house

next to the cemetery and damage from construction vehicles. He advised that we should take care of this work ourselves. We will contact South East Fence for an estimate.
