

Lakeville Cemetery Commission
Meeting Minutes
May 24, 2016

Meeting called to order at 9:05 a.m. by Chairman Upham.

Members Present: Commissioners Upham, Beal and Morton.

Guests Present: None

Minutes of the April 12, 2016 meeting were read and approved.

Financial Report was tabled until the next meeting.

Old Business:

A letter was sent to Robin Reynolds. Town records show that she owes money to the town for her plot. If she has not paid her outstanding balance by July 20, 2016, her previous payment will be returned to her and the plot will be returned to the town.

A discussion was held re ownership of the Cornell plot in Precinct Cemetery.

A letter was sent to Mr. Santos who owes for perpetual care at Precinct Cemetery. No burials will be allowed at his plot until this bill is paid.

New Business:

A discussion of the maintenance schedule for the town cemeteries led to the decision that we should prioritize which cemeteries need the most crucial work done.

Someone is stealing stones from the back wall at Strobridge Cemetery. This has been reported to town authorities. Commissioner Beal made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Morton, to accept the proposal from South East Fence to install two new gates there.

A proposal from South East Fence for repairs at Booth 2 Cemetery was reviewed. We also have an estimate from a new fence company on Rte 44. Tabled until the next meeting.

Commissioner Beal will contact fence companies for estimates for work at McCully and Ward Cemeteries.

Rails at Hatford Cemetery are all bent.

A motion was made and seconded to pay for half of the new lawn mower for the Highway Department.

Deeds were signed for the Salvato and Bourgault plots at the Veterans Cemetery.

A discussion took place re how to irrigate the grass at the Veterans Cemetery. Commissioner Upham will meet with A.A. Will to see if they have any ideas to help us.

A motion was made and seconded to pay all bills.
