

# Cemetery Commission Meeting Minutes

October 14, 2014

Meeting called to order at 9:02 AM by Chairman Upham.

Members Present: Ken Upham, Fred Beal, Joan Glade Morton

There was no financial Report. Fred will get the information from Cindy and forward it to us.

Minutes of the September 16, 2014 meeting were read and accepted.

## Old Business:

1. Fred is still researching computer software programs for a good data base and mapping, which is our main focus. Fred will check with Cindy re the two programs she recommended. Thompson Hill, Precinct, Clark and Lang have the most open plots. Tabled until the next meeting.
2. The Highway Dept. will set the signs for Howland and Pickersgill. Malbone has been set. Pierce and Hafford still need to be done.

## New Business:

1. Hafford Cemetery is on private property. The landowner asked the Highway Dept. to leave. There is a 10 foot easement/right of way on the left side. Ken will take a copy of the deed and explain this to her.
2. There was a discussion re a Veterans section to be developed within Thompson Hill. The plot would be free for the Veteran. The opening would be paid for by the family. The spouse would pay the full amount for their plot, opening and perpetual care.

A motion was made by Joan and seconded by Fred to establish a Veterans section within Thompson Hill.

at Thompson Hill. There would be 200 plots - 100 for veterans and 100 for spouses.

We will order a 25 foot fiberglass flagpole from HAMCO, to be set in the spring. John Pink has maps of the cemeteries. We will contact him to lay it out for us.

3. We will place signs at Pond, Precinct, Thompson Hill and Clark Cemeteries citing regulations re interference in plots. Items placed outside the 18 inch limit will be removed.
