

Lakeville Cemetery Commission

Meeting Minutes

December 11, 2018

The meeting was called to order at 1:06 p.m. by Chairman Upham in the Local History Room of the Lakeville Public Library.

Members present: Commissioners Upham, Beal and Morton.

Guests: None

Minutes of the October 9, 2018 were read and approved.

Working with a revised budget, our current balance is \$15,616.82.

Old Business:

1. John Meleedy from South East Fence assured Ken last week that the fence between Precinct and Thompson Hill Cemeteries would soon be installed. The granite posts will be set and the rods will be placed at a later date.
2. John Pink has completed his surveying at Strobridge Cemetery. He wants to know the plot size, which is 5' by 10'. He will add that to his survey.
3. The post and rail fence at the front of Ward Cemetery has been completed. There is no gate. Boards need to be lifted up to get in, since they are resting on U-bolts. Fred will contact South East Fence to discuss the gate, suggesting that maybe it would be possible to make the boards slide to the side to open.
4. Beaver Tree Works has finished the work at McCully Cemetery. South East Fence will reset the granite post and rods at the front and fix the rods at the rear. Beaver Tree Works will pay for the damage.

New Business:

1. The issue re the Whitney plot at Pond Cemetery has been resolved.
2. Colleen Allen wants to place a monument between her father and her uncle at Thompson Hill Cemetery. It should be an 18 grave plot and there are only 12 buried there. Her father was the last living relative, so Colleen should be the owner. Richard says he is the owner, affirmed by Wendell. Wendell died, so Wayne should be the rightful owner, then his daughter Colleen. We will send a letter to Colleen giving her permission to place a monument on her identified lot.

The meeting was adjourned at 1:40 p.m.
