New Business:

1. The Cemetery Commission will attend a joint meeting of the Selectmen and Finance Committee in March. Chairman Upham will make his annual presentation at this meeting.
2. Projects for 2019 were discussed. The walls at McCully Cemetery need to be repaired. We will seek someone to do this job. We would like to complete the fence between Precinct and Thompson Hill Cemeteries. We will look for a vendor who has old granite posts.
3. We will put off repairing the back fence at Ward Cemetery for now, but leave it on the table for future discussion.

4. We will get a proposal from South East Fence to straighten the rods at Haskins Cemetery.
5. We will plan to check our cemeteries after winter for damage. If possible, we will check them before the next meeting.
6. Ken Leonard is designing an emblem to be placed in the sidewalk at the burial site of Native Americans Thomas and William Smith near the Indian Shore Cemetery complex.
