- Commissioner Mansfield will contact Superintendent of Streets Peck to transfer stored steel railings from OCVHS and house them at the Town Barn.
- Brush is starting to inhibit access to Pierce cemetery. Superintendent Peck will be contacted to address cuttings.
- Commissioner Mansfield informed the Commission he would, as time allows, cut back small brush affecting the integrity of cemetery walls.

state laws for discussion at a later date.
