

**Conservation Commission
Meeting Minutes
June 10, 2008**

The Conservation Commission held a meeting on June 10, 2008 in the Lakeville Town Office Building. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Orrall at 7:00 p.m. Members present were Bob Bouchard, Joe Chamberlain, Randall Kenney, Emery Orrall and Martha Schroeder. Jennifer Jewell, recording secretary was also present. Michael Toole was absent with prior notice.

7:00 P.M. – 123 Nelson’s Grove Road

Nyberg

It was noted that while the Fisheries Commission has jurisdictional rights for any water entering the Taunton River Watershed there has been no communication with this group. Upon motion made by Member Chamberlain and seconded by Member Schroeder the Commission

VOTED: To continue the hearing to July 8, 2008 at 7:00 p.m. Unanimous vote.

Agent Selection Committee

The Commission must appoint two members to a selection committee. This committee will review the applications and provide a list of qualified candidates to the Commission. Upon motion made by Member Bouchard and seconded by Member Kenney the Commission

VOTED: To appoint Members Chamberlain and Schroeder to the Agent Selection Committee. Unanimous vote.

Woods Edge

At the request of a resident, Mr. Kenney visited the site to ascertain whether the drainage swale along the roadway posed a danger to motorists. It was stated that while a swale is located adjacent to the roadway that item does not fall under the jurisdiction of the Commission. There was discussion regarding access to private property.

County Road

Degrazia

Bob Rego, from Prime Engineering, was present for the discussion. There was a review of the plans. It was stated that a wetland crossing would be necessary to access the upland portion of the site. Mr. Rego stated that the Planning Board wanted confirmation from the Commission that the 15,000 square foot wetland crossing and five lot subdivision with a conventional roadway was a permissible project before voting to allow a reduction in the roadway width, which would require a 6,000 square foot crossing. There was question as to the possible location for wetland replication. The Commission voiced concern over the impact of the proposed large crossing and stated that they would not look favorably on such a filing.

Rhode Island Road

Johnson

It was stated that the property owner was in violation and was supposed to file with the Commission in the past. Chairman Orrall will draft a letter to DEP regarding the history of the case and forward a copy to the Board of Selectmen.

Keller Waterproofing

It was stated that a large concrete stockpile has been developing on the site. Member Chamberlain will visit the site to speak with the property owner.
