1. Ecoharvester project:

Ron explained the large excavator was given to us to use in place of the trailer and worked better and was much faster. The trailer would have cost us \$500 a day.

Dave made motion to pay \$500 for the use of the trailer for day one and day two since we had it on site to put weeds in. Funds would be taken from the New Bedford portion of the funding and then remainder from the Lakeville line item.
