OPEN SPACE PLAN

An **Open Space Plan** is the expression of a town's vision for the future of its open spaces and helps guide future decision-making about environmental resources

- Towns with approved Plans become eligible for grant programs (state funds for open space purchases)
 - Plans must be updated every 7 years to continue to be eligible for grants
- Lakeville's Open Space Plan was last updated in 2012
 - The Open Space Committee is currently working on the next update

COMMUNITY INPUT

- A paramount goal of every Open Space Plan is to **accurately represent the perspectives of the community**
- **Surveys** are an effective method for assessing community perspectives because:
 - Any resident can easily participate
 - The sample is large, so it is not overly-influenced by the opinions of a few people
 - Questions can be asked in a non-biasing way, lending confidence to results

OPEN SPACE SURVEY

- Leaflets announcing the survey were mailed with tax documents in July, along with directions to participate
- The survey was available for two months (closed on September 1)
- There were 802 valid responses from 700 households
 - 98% of survey responses were submitted online via [SurveyMonkey.com](https://www.surveymonkey.com)
 - 2% of survey responses were submitted on paper at the Town Library, Senior Center, or Town Hall
- \$100 was donated for use as a randomized prize giveaway - winner to be announced at the end of this presentation

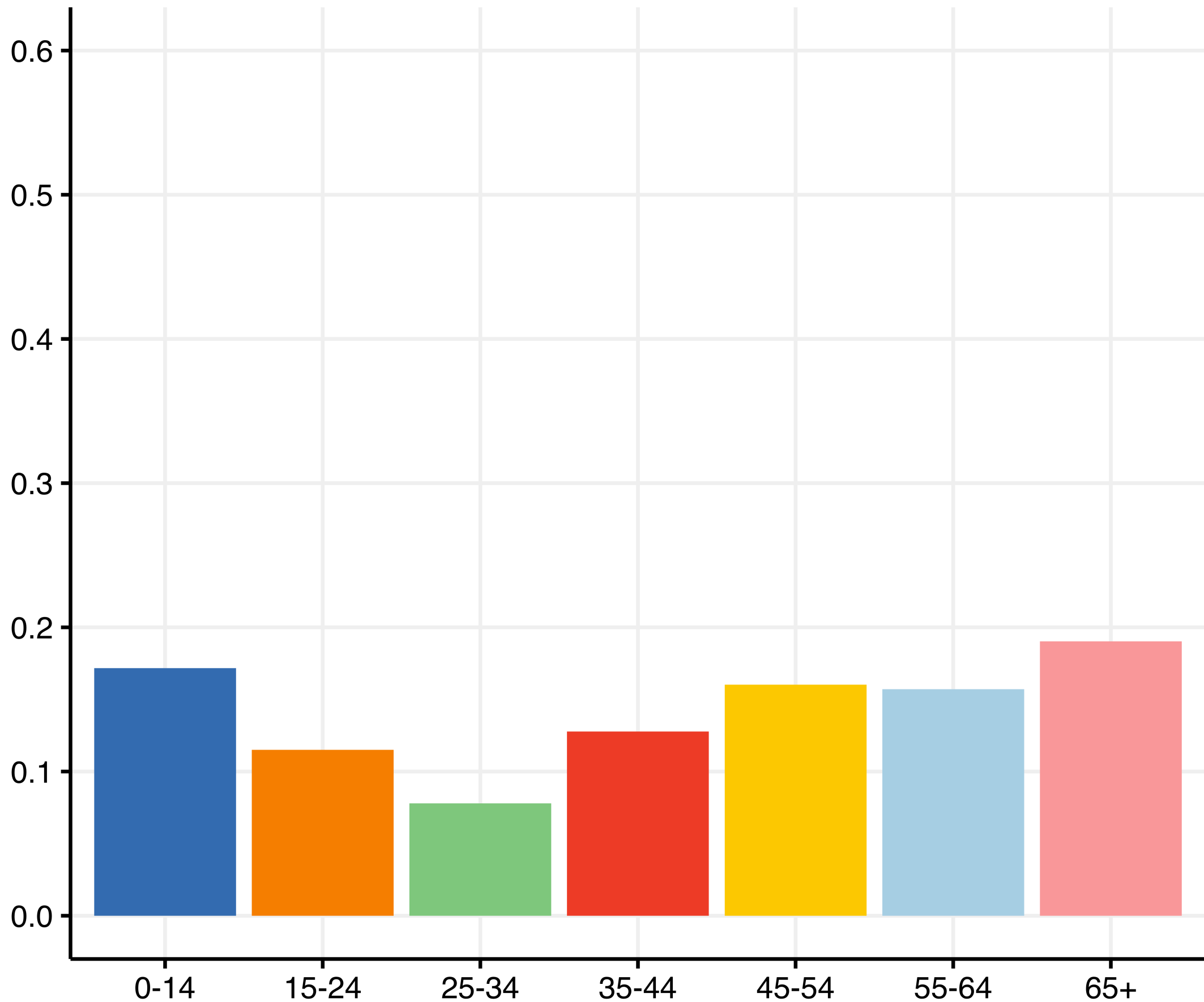

Proportion of Residents in Sampled Households



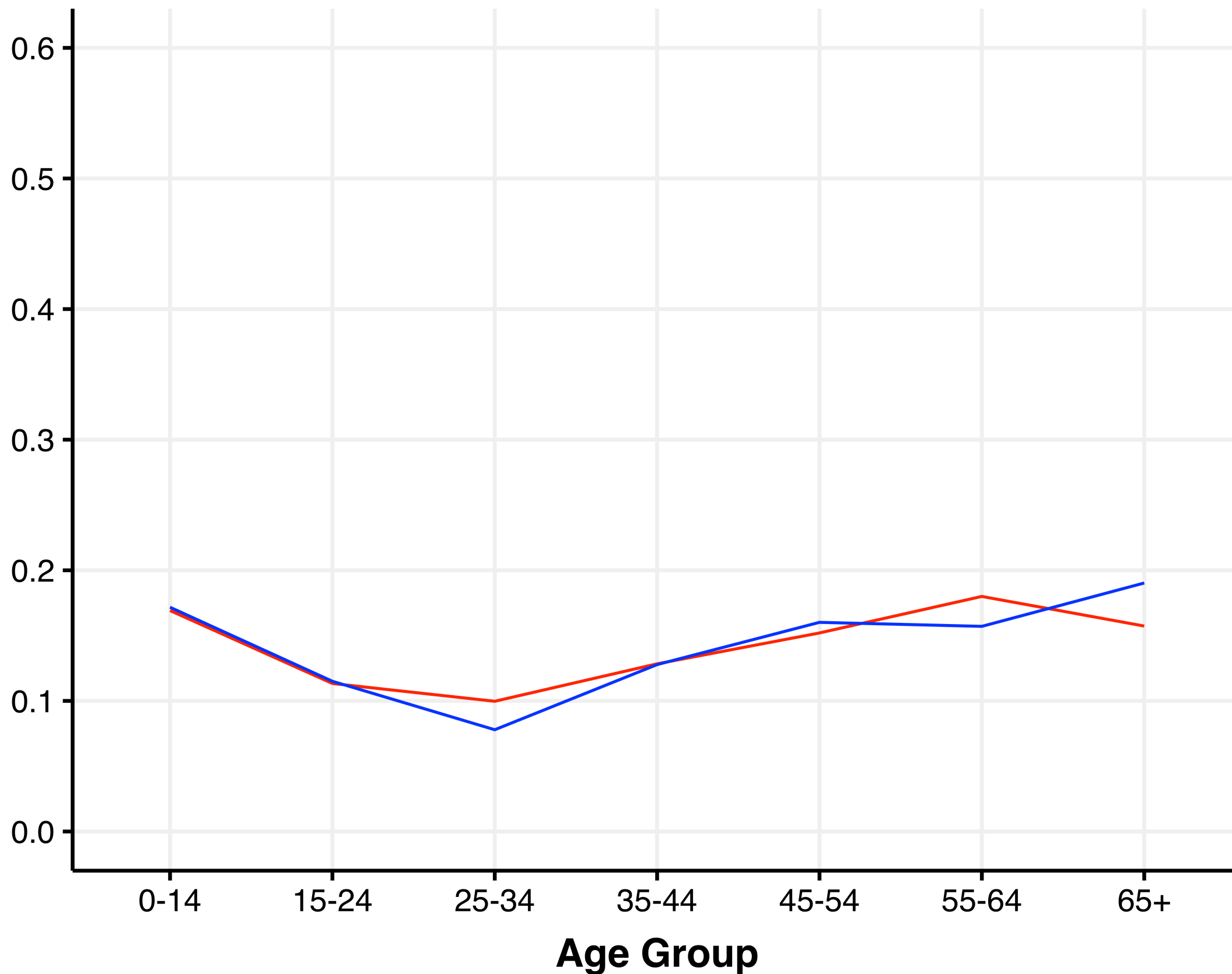

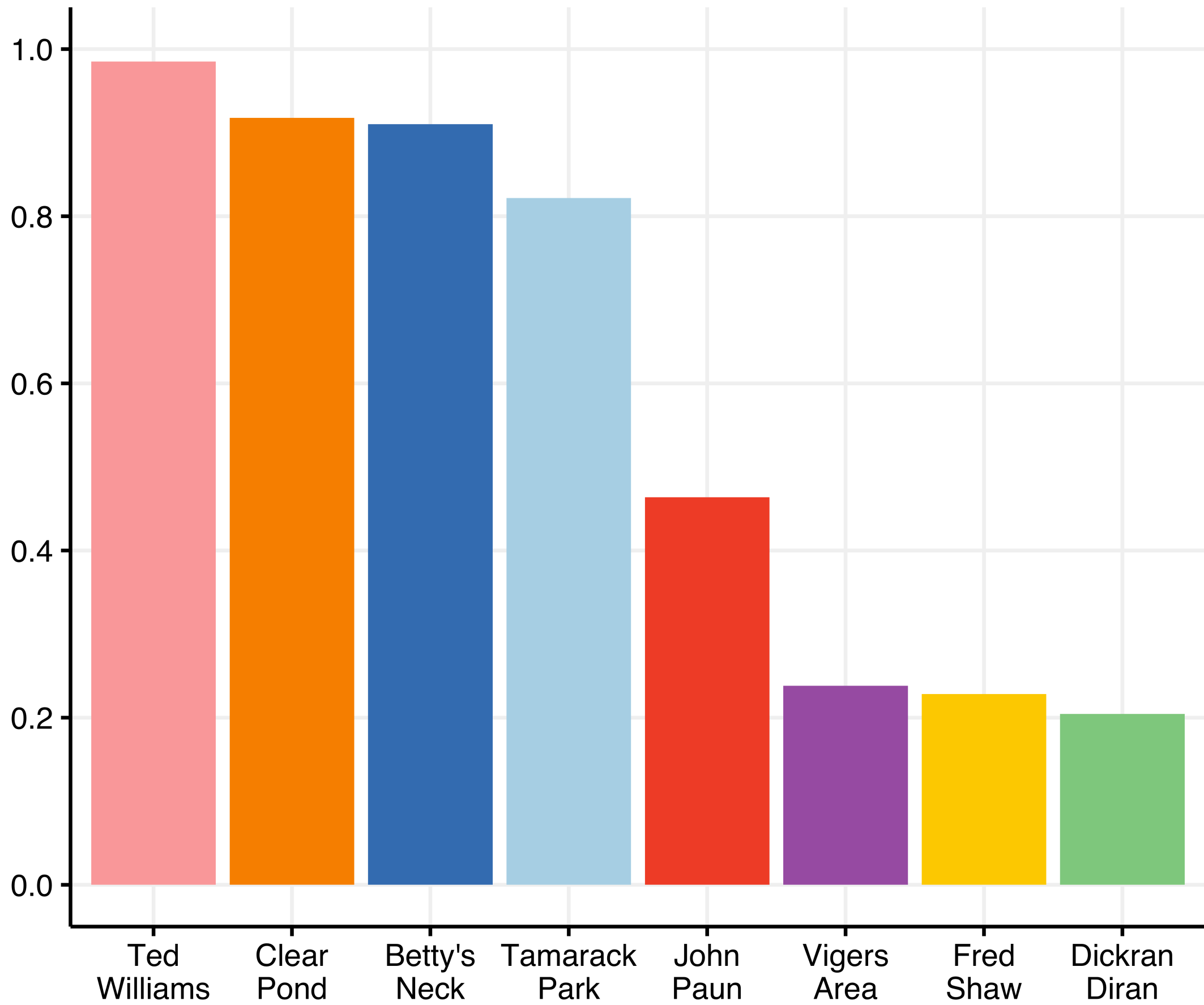

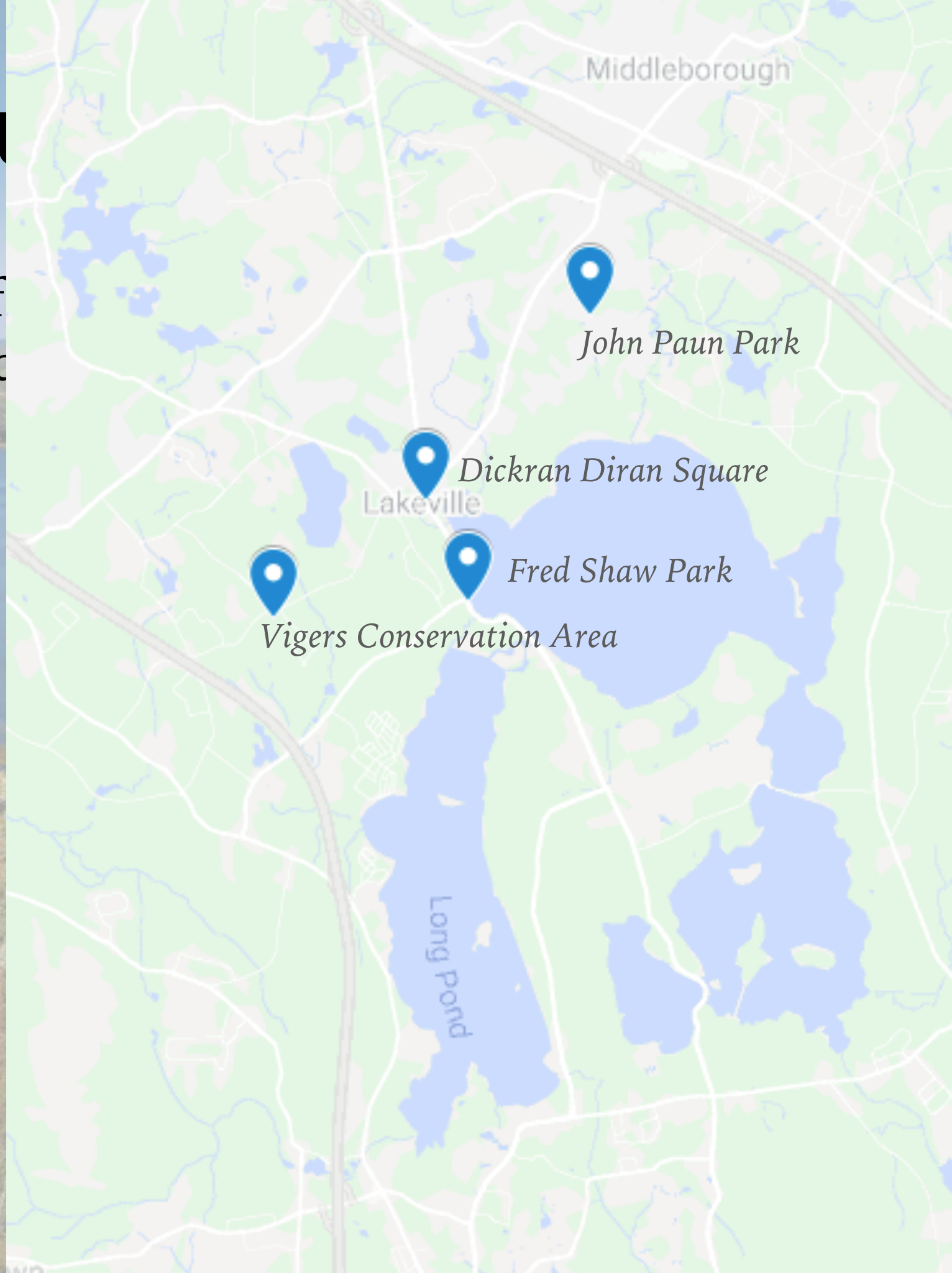

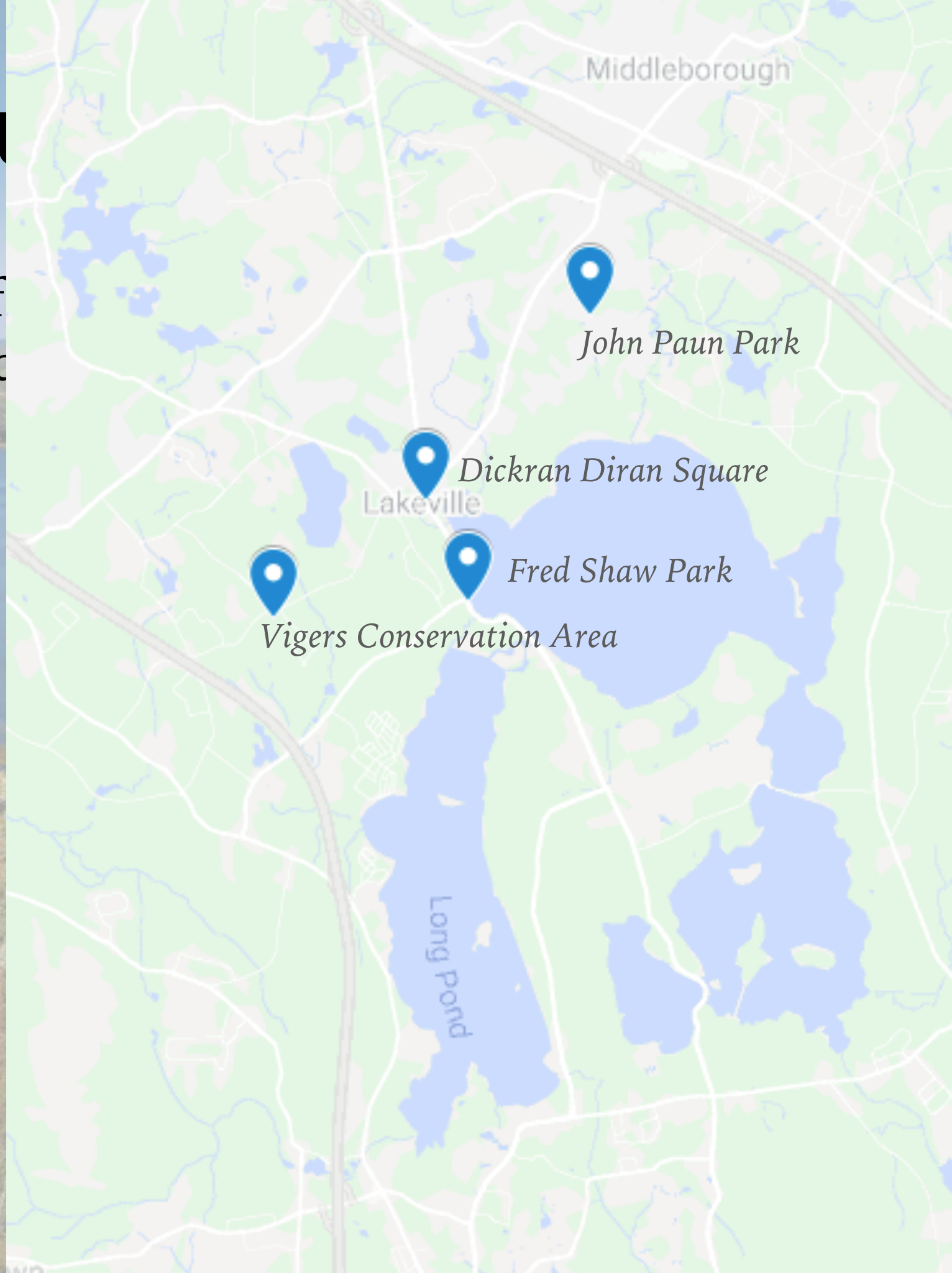

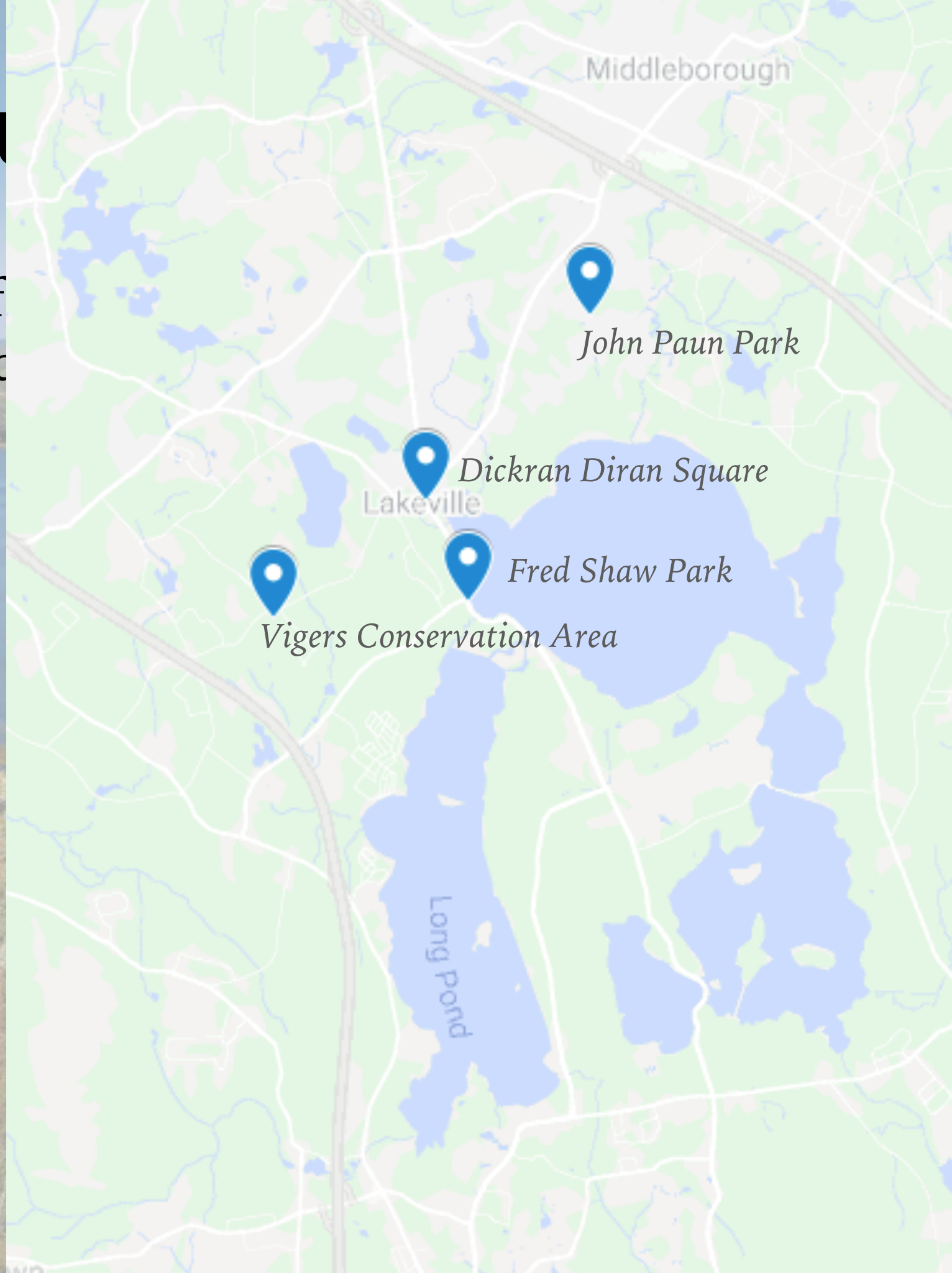

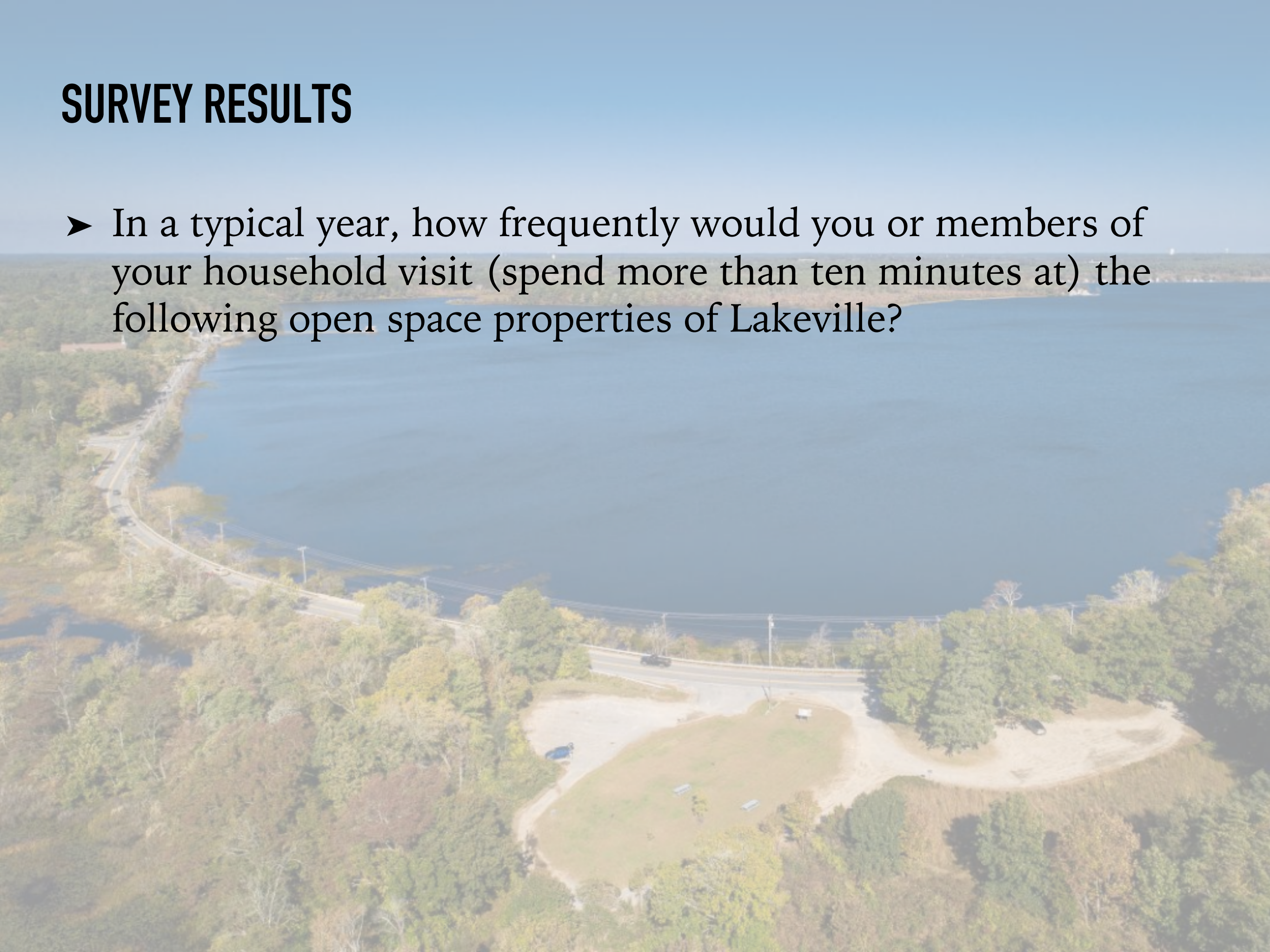

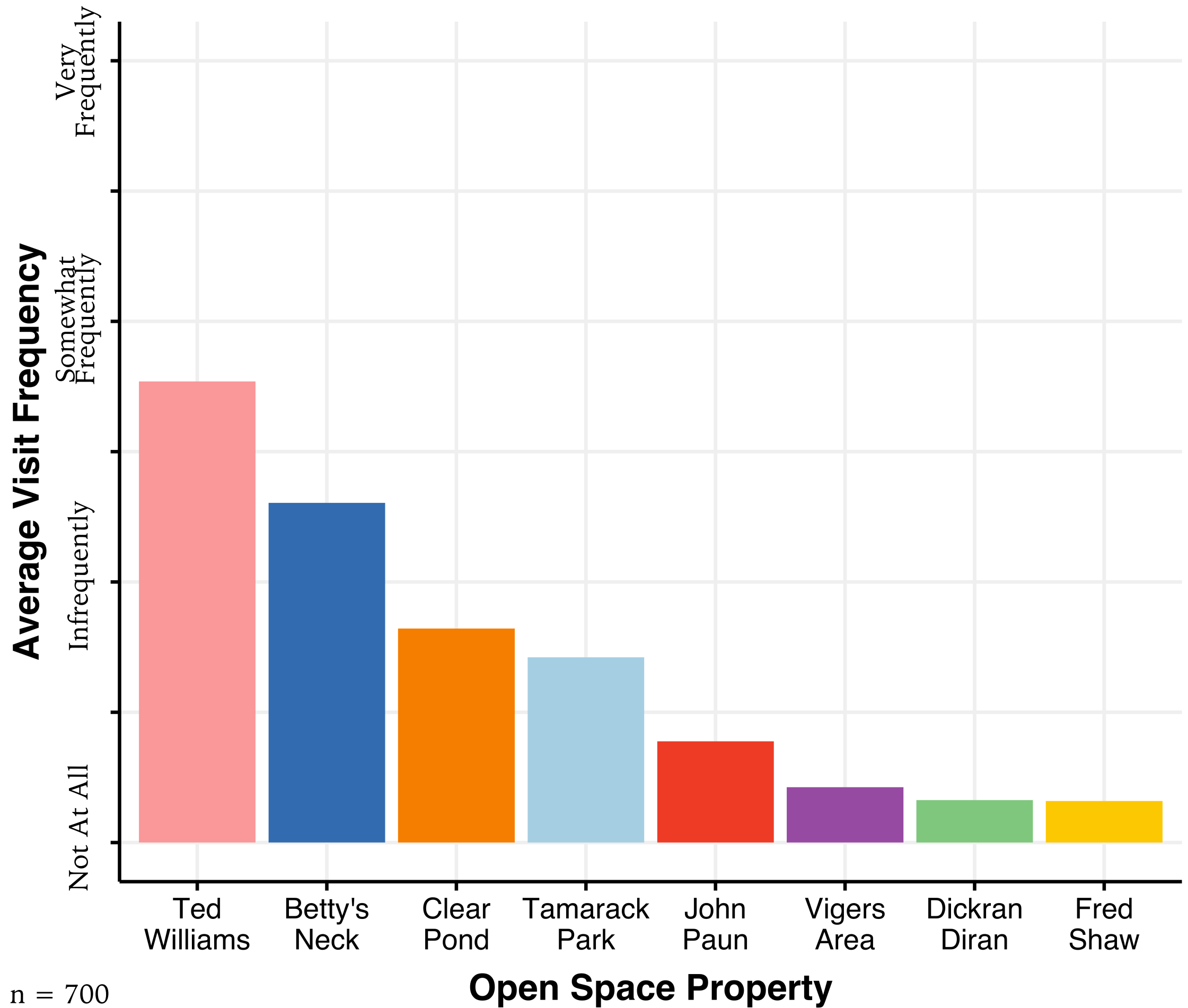

- In a typical year, how frequently would you or members of your household visit (spend more than ten minutes at) the following open space properties of Lakeville?



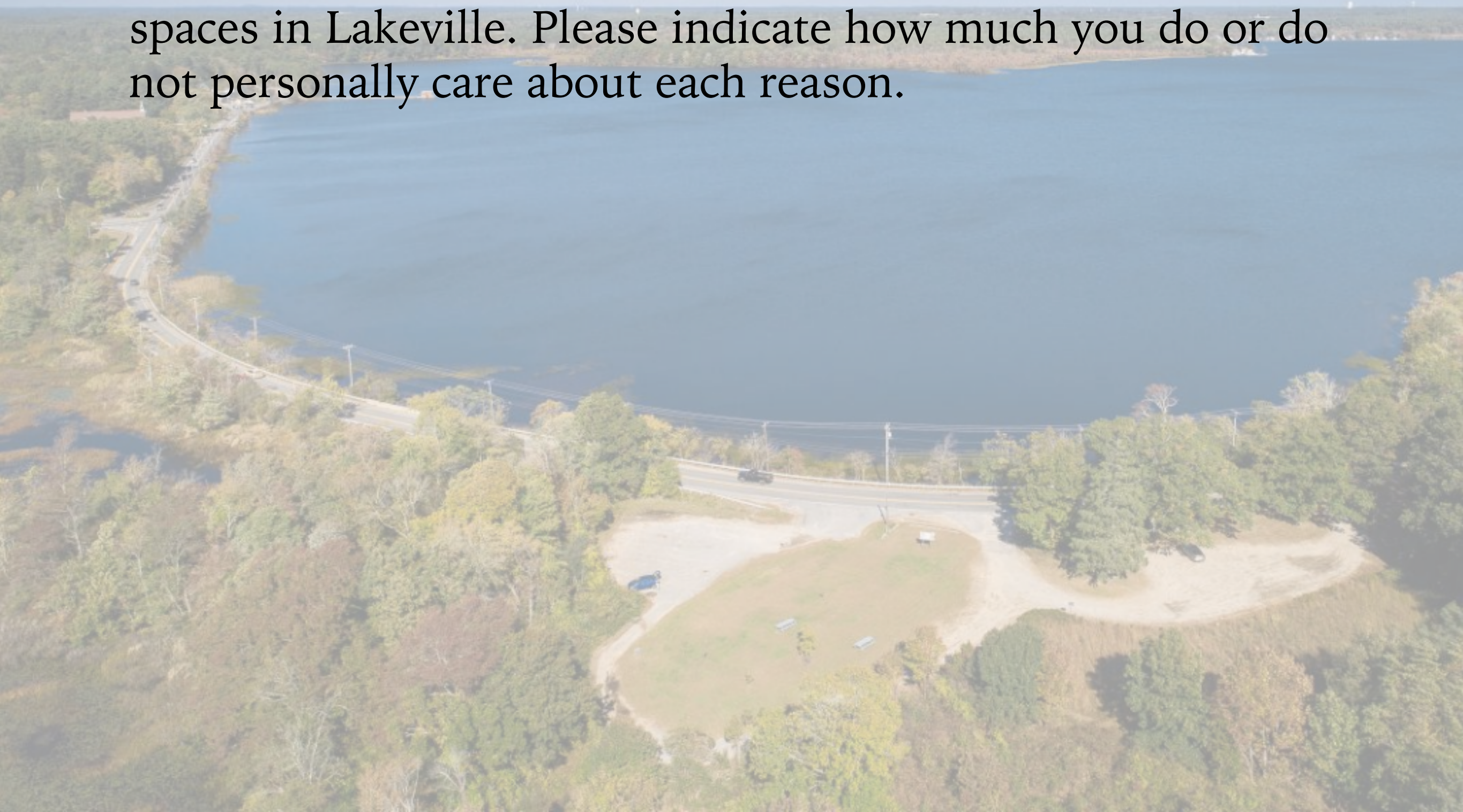

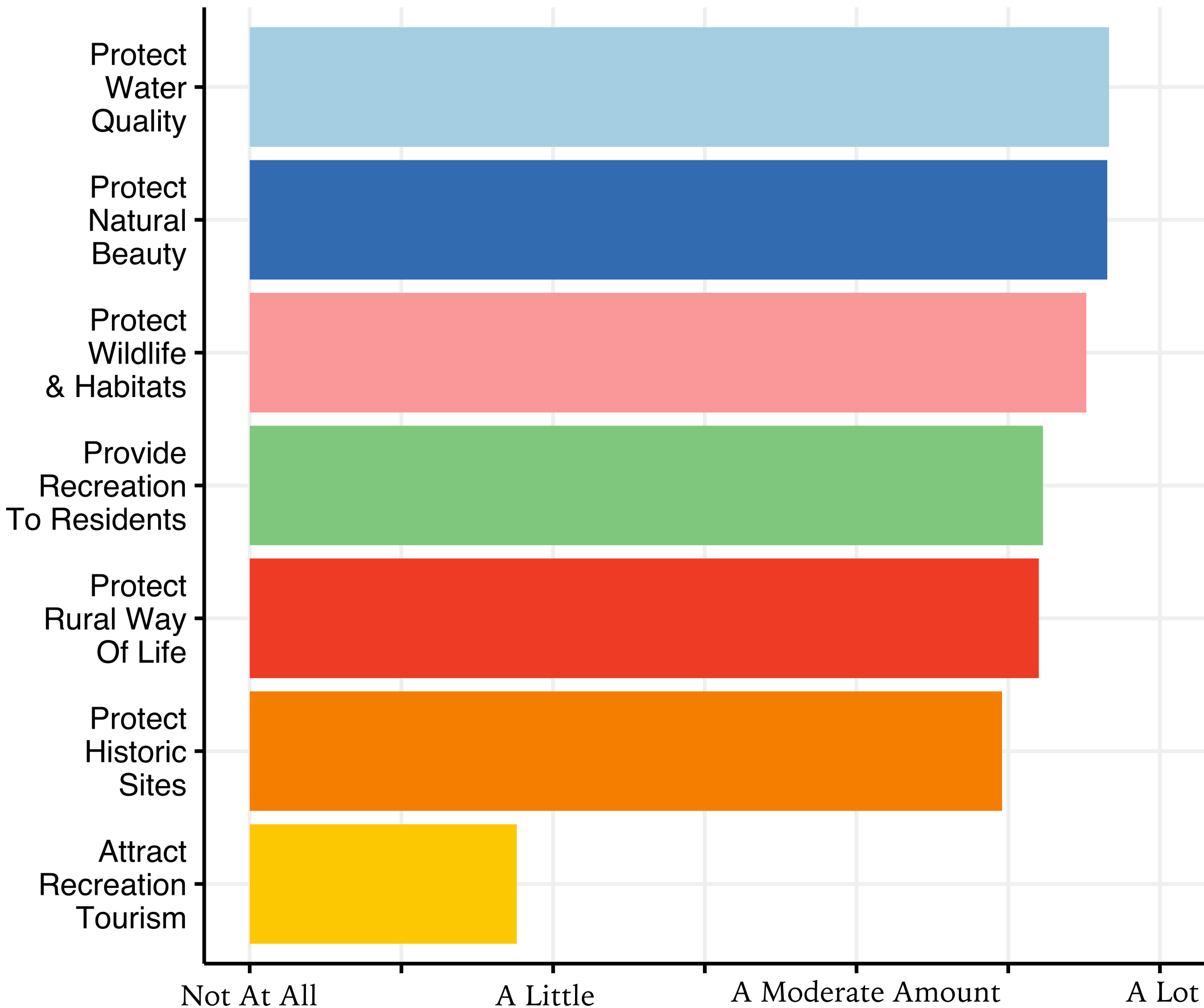

Reason for Protection



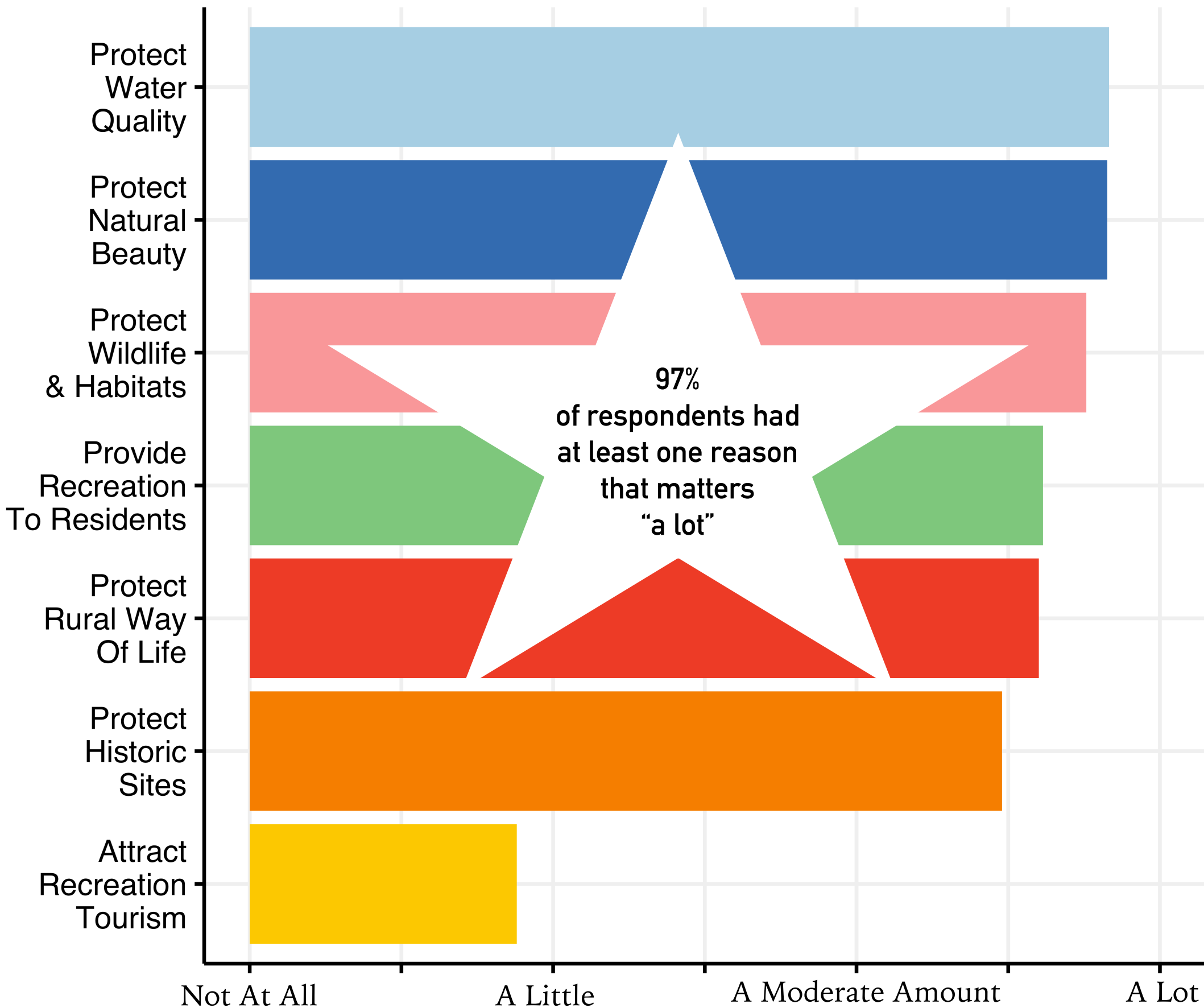

SURVEY RESULTS

- The Community Preservation Act (CPA) is a state law that allows local communities to create a dedicated fund to protect open spaces, recreation areas, and historic resources, and to provide affordable housing on the Town's terms (instead of via Chapter 40B).

The CPA requires an increase to local real estate taxes (estimated \$39/year for average household), but receives matching funds from the State. If passed, an independent Community Preservation Committee would make project recommendations, and all spending must be approved at Town Meeting.

For example, CPA funds could be used to purchase a piece of land in town and convert it to a park, rather than see it sold to a developer for industrial use or high density housing.

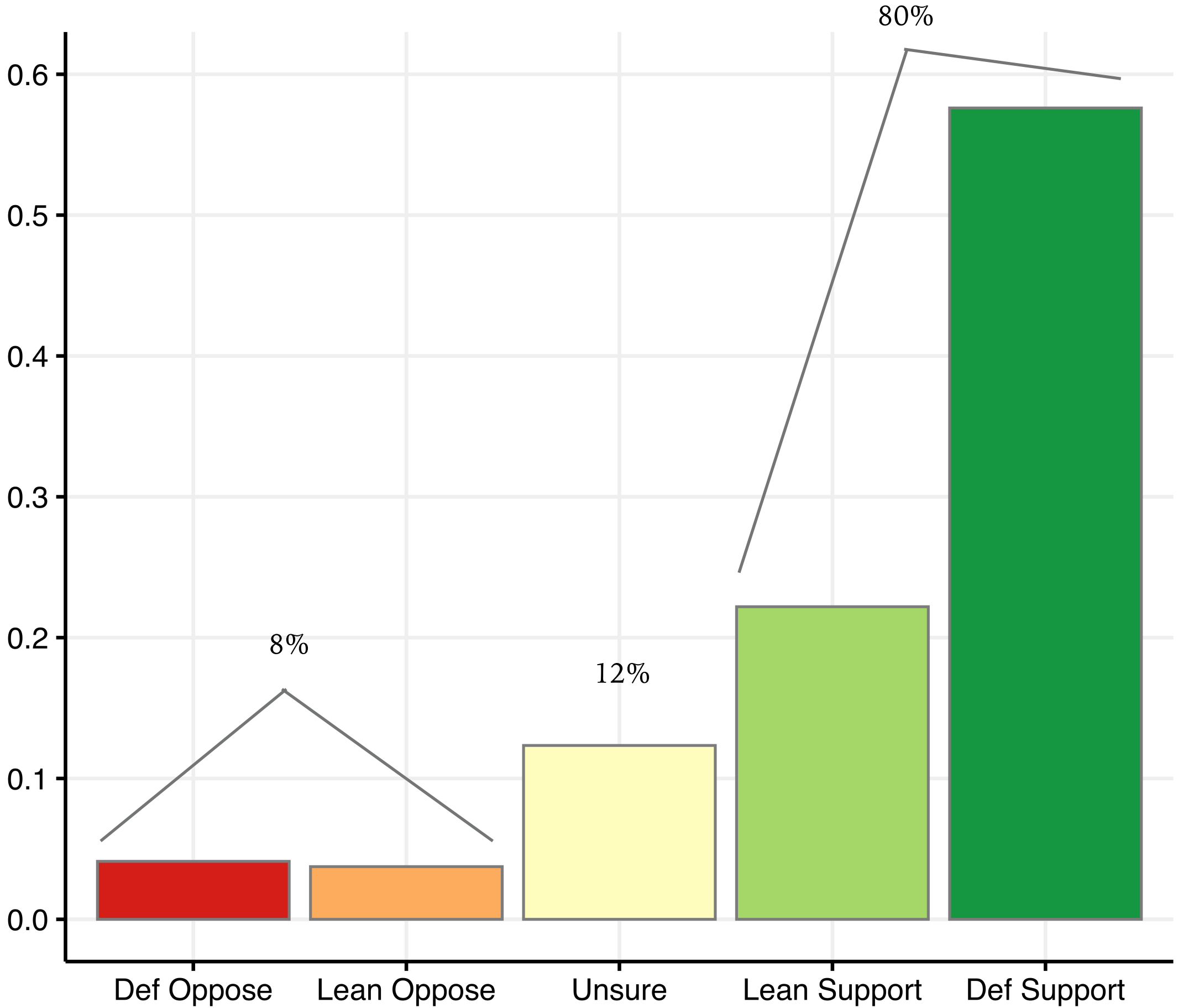
Hypothetically, would you support or oppose the adoption of the Community Preservation Act in Lakeville?

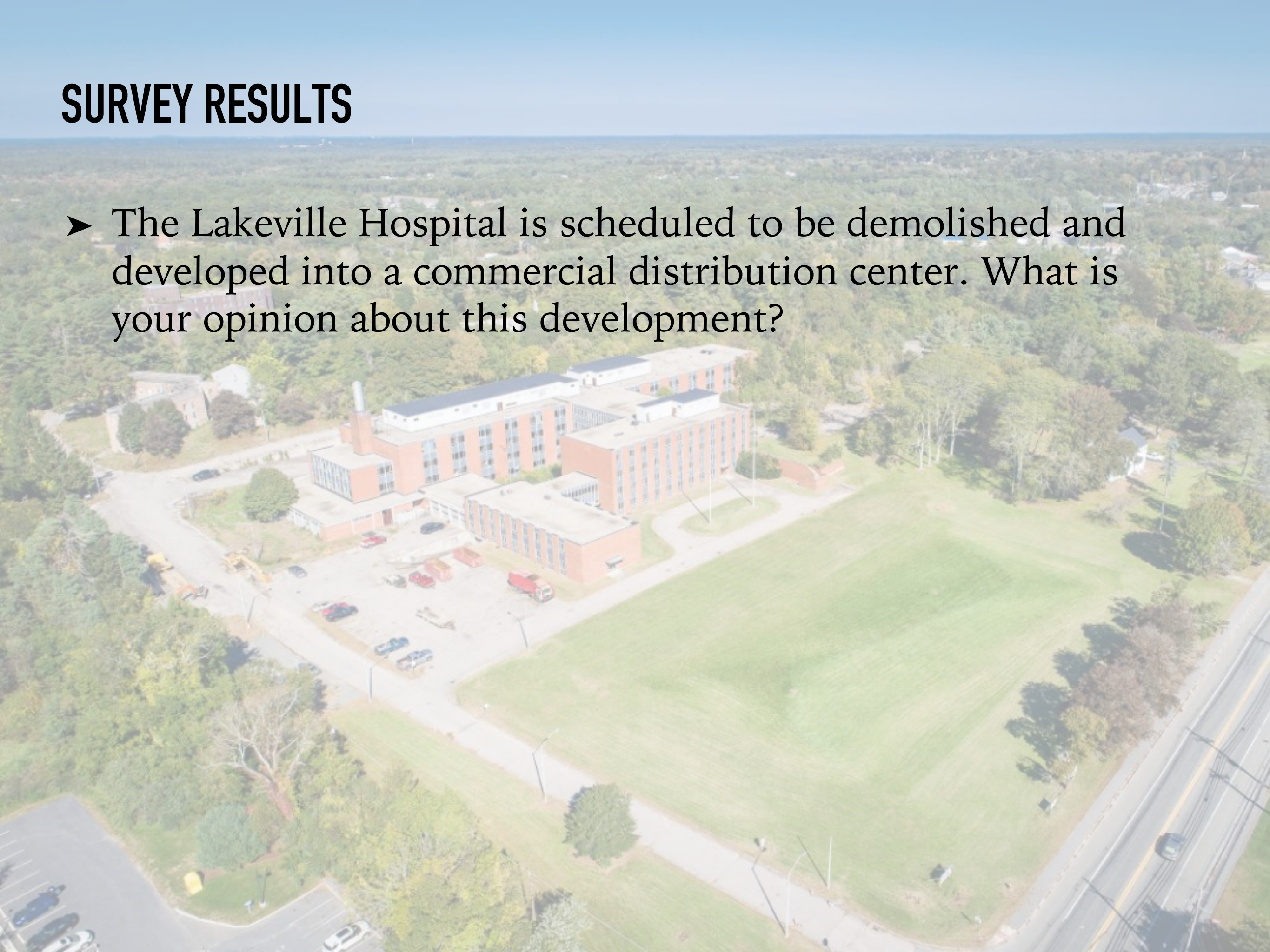

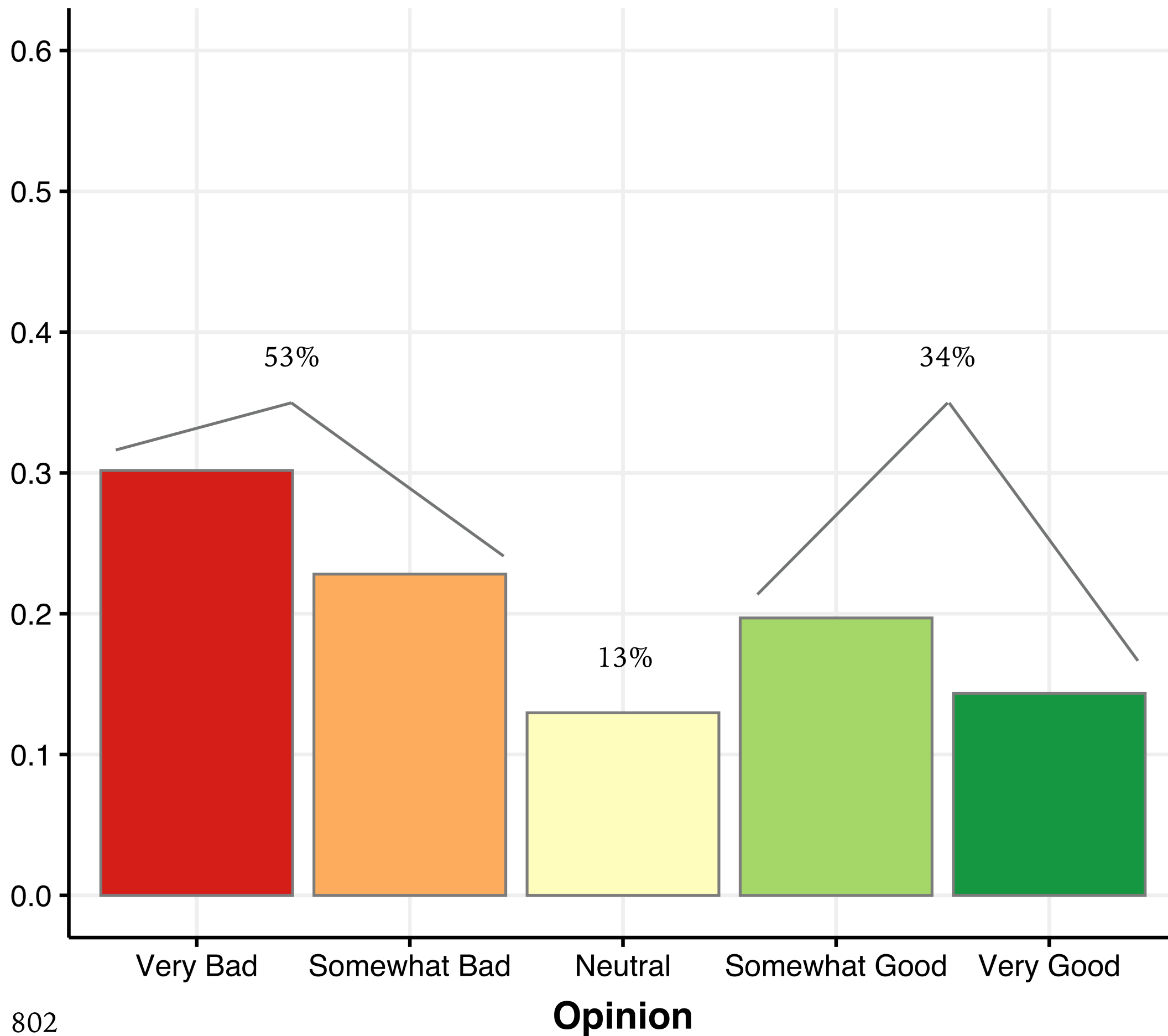

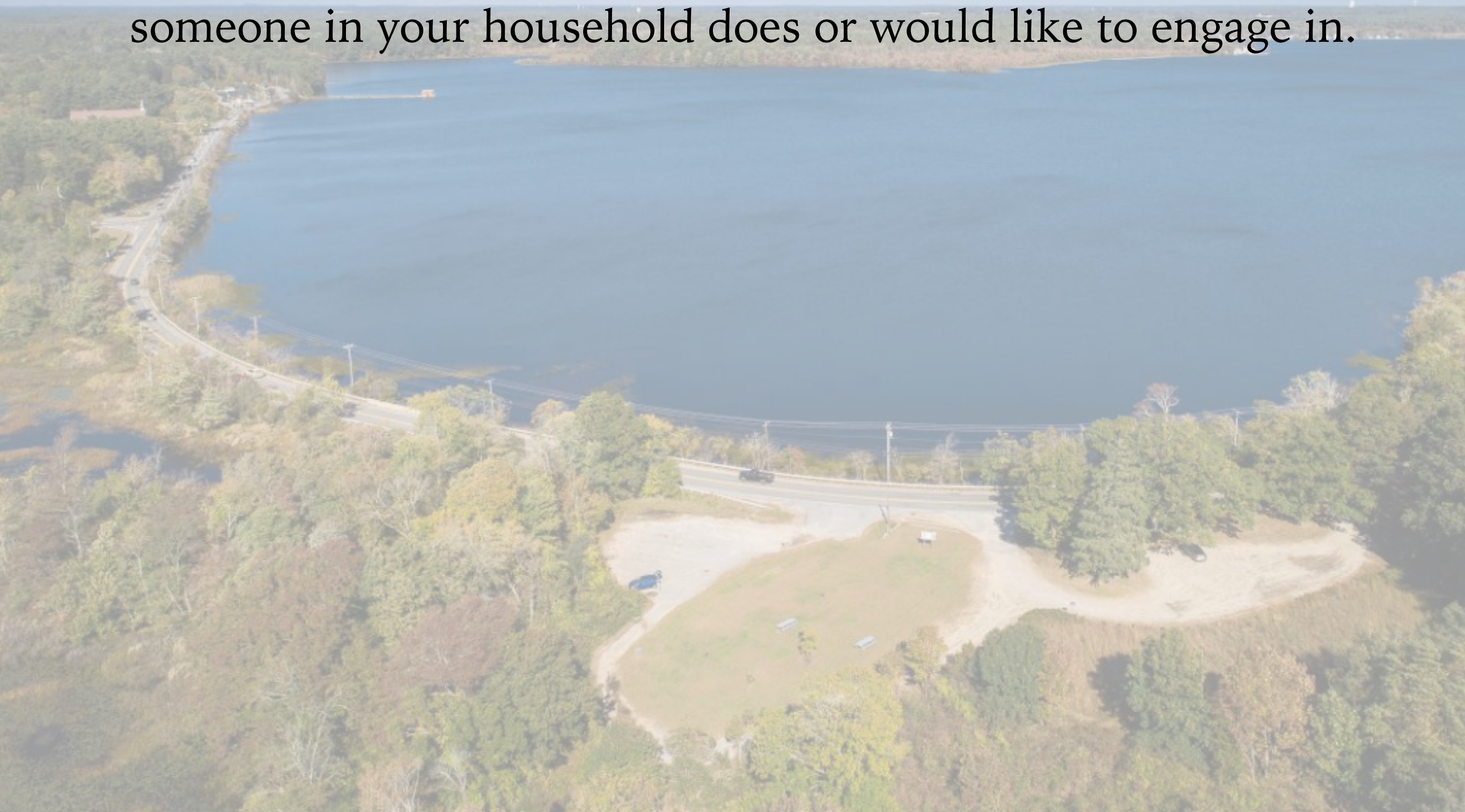

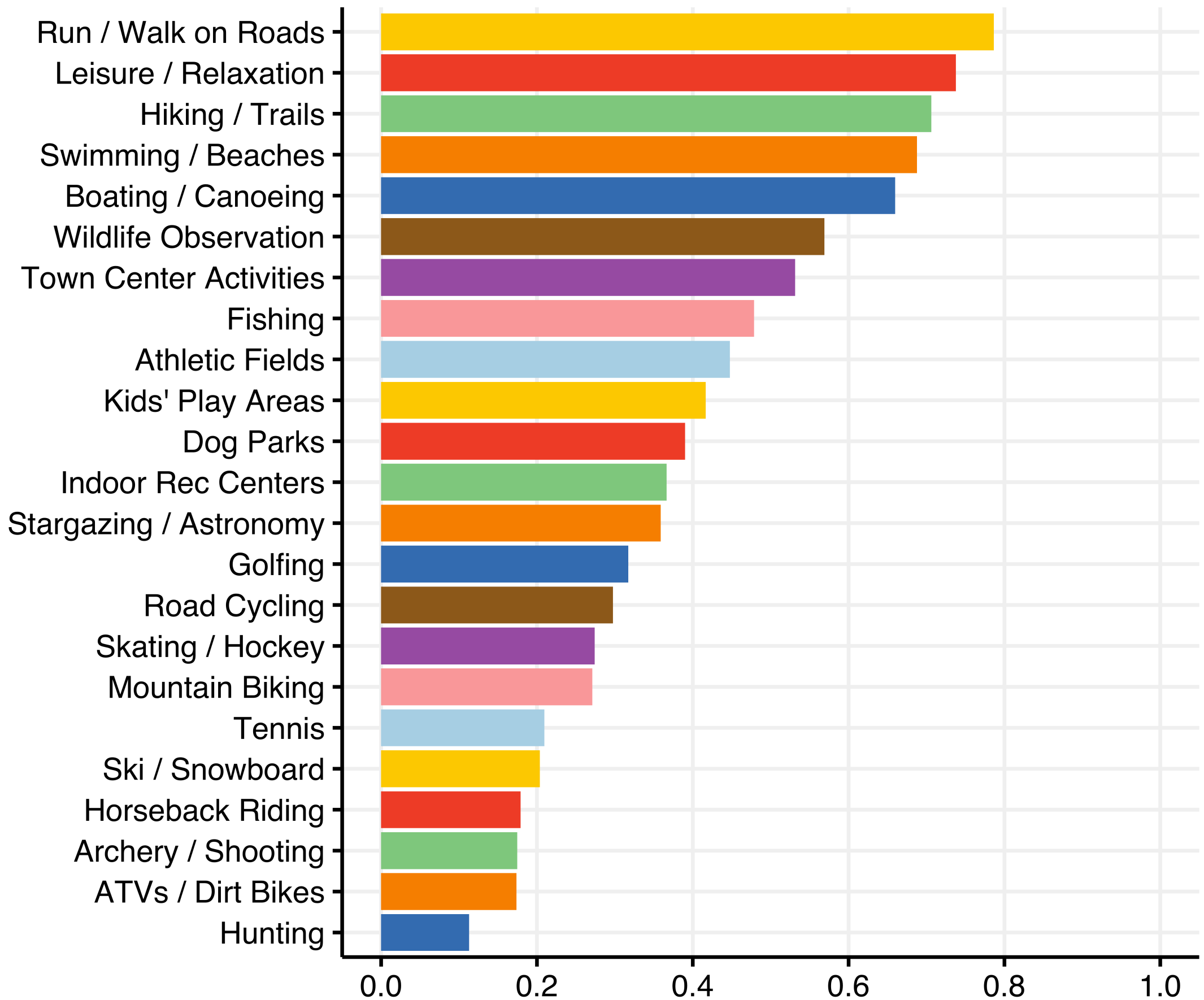
- Please select which recreation activities below you or someone in your household does or would like to engage in.

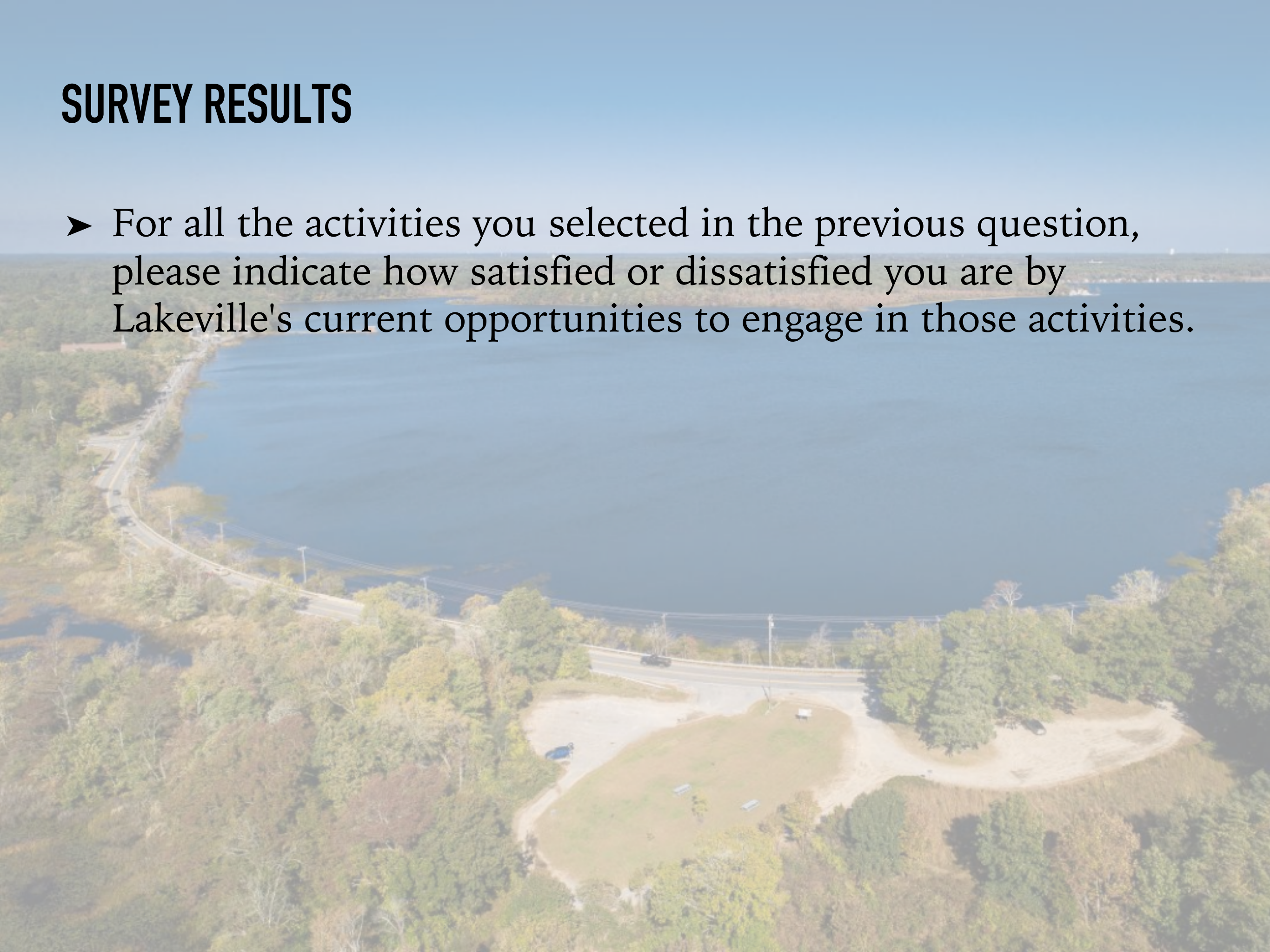


