Nancy Yeatts came as a liaison from the Selectmen to discuss the expansion of the Island Terrace septic system. The Open Space Committee has stated that it does not approve of breaking the conservation restriction that is on the parcel which Island Terrace wants to purchase from the Town to expand its septic system. It should be noted that Island Terrace could buy a parcel of land from Decas Cranberries, but it is considered too costly by them. Nancy came to ask what the Open Space Committee would like to have as a protected parcel to compensate for this. Don made a motion, seconded by Joan, to ask that the remainder of the 600 acres property on Howland road be traded for permanent protection. Island Terrace will be responsible for all fees involved. Nancy will report back to the Selectmen.

The Assessors' Office no longer had deed books and all info is on CD's. The Committee wants to be able to find and keep track of deed restrictions. We want to know if it is possible to add a column to specify these in the assessors' records. Don suggested asking Gordon Goodfellow if what we want to do is feasible.
