There was a short discussion concerning what to do about members who regularly do not attend meetings. Selectmen have a policy which states that if you miss three meetings you could be removed. We have two members who fit this category.

Brian moved to accept the minutes of June 9. Joan seconded. Minutes approved.

Comparison of old and new surveys: Results were close, except where people were asked if they would spend money to preserve open space. Those who responded were less likely than were those who responded to the old survey.

The new survey will be added to the Appendices of the Open Space Plan.

Don will prepare a survey comparison document for the selectmen.

Linda will incorporate the ADA reports into the plan.

We will set a date with the Selectmen to present them with the results of the new survey, which they recommended. We will also present them with a copy of the plan, which is now ready to go to the state.

We will also tell the Selectmen that pursuing the CPA for Lakeville is not a project for the Open Space Committee.

We will recommend to the Selectmen that they show support for the new bottle bill.

The Open Space Committee will recommend that the town take a parcel of land on Main Street diagonal to the Eliot Farm and preserve it as open space. It is wet and undevelopable.
