We discussed going before the Master Plan Implementation Committee meeting June 12 for their input on the Open Space Plan. We will also go before the Planning Board, Water Study Board and Board of Health

We reviewed status of revision of plan's sections. Section 5 is done. Anyone with revision questions can send to all members, but responses should be direct and not "to all". Linda reminded us that the organizations in the TRWA Campaign have offered us assistance.

We discussed the need to familiarize ourselves with Lakeville's existing open space parcels. We will visit the Town Forest, the night soil deposit area and Vigers Conservation Area Sunday June 22 meeting at the Town Hall at 10:00 a.m.

Linda reported that Horsley-Witten's Taunton River study which looks at sub-watersheds and measures flow says the Assonet and Taunton Rivers are stressed. She has on-line files of their presentation and handbook and will send them to those who want.

We briefly discussed our other responsibilities but agreed need to focus first on the OS Plan.
