Pursuant to G.L. c. 40A, § 9 and the Lakeville Zoning Bylaw, Sections, 6.7, 7.4 and 7.9, **Rhino Capital Advisors, LLC** has filed an application for **Site Plan Review** and **Special Permit** within the Development Opportunities District with the Lakeville Planning Board and a **Notice of Intent (NOI)** with the Lakeville Conservation Commission pursuant to G.L. c, 131, § 40 seeking approval to redevelop the former Lakeville State Hospital Site located at **43 Main Street, Lakeville**.
