Message:

Dear Neli,

I am reaching out on behalf of Native Plant Trust (formerly the New England Wild Flower Society). We are a nonprofit conservation organization that works to monitor and protect sensitive native plant species throughout New England.

We are interested in having a trained botanist conduct a brief survey for a population of a plant called New England boneset (*Trichostema brachiatum*) that we believe may be located at Loon Pond near Ted Williams Camp. Because this plant is a wetland species, this survey would require us to launch a canoe/kayak to survey the shoreline via boat. The survey would take approximately 2-3 hours and would not affect the property in any way.

Our field methods include counting plants, measuring population area, and taking notes on ecological habitat characteristics. Surveyors may also take diagnostic images of plants and habitat. The information from this visit will be shared with CT's Natural Heritage database to update their records of plant populations. We hope the information gathered will help us to better understand the biology of these species and ultimately develop better conservation strategies.

We are more than happy to send a report of our findings to you at the end of the season. Please let me know if you have any questions or would like additional information and I look forward to hearing from you soon. Thanks!
