




Here are some statistics on the property easements/takings based on the 25% plans:

# Why Do This Project?

 Federal Highway and State are paying for 100% of construction cost

- If we don't, the cost of the project will be 5 to 6 Million without sidewalks and no reimbursement from the State
- It will only cost the Town \$2.3 Million
- Will lose grant money
