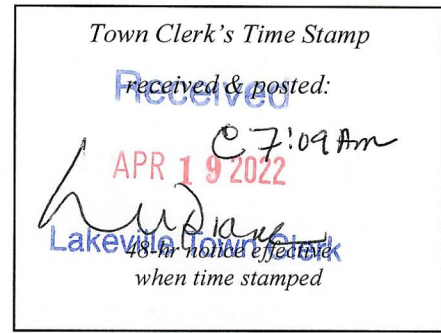




TOWN OF LAKEVILLE MEETING POSTING & AGENDA REMOTE MEETING
