Furniture Polish, Drain & Oven Cleaners, Mercury Thermometers, Aerosol Cans, Metal Polish, Lighter Fluid, Fluorescent Bulbs, Rechargeable Batteries, Photo Chemicals



Garage

Motor Oil, Antifreeze, Gasoline, Automobile Batteries, Engine Degreaser, Brake Fluid, Transmission Fluid, Driveway Sealer, Auto Waxes and Polishes



Shed

Pesticides, Insecticides, Pool Chemicals, Lead Sinkers, Creosote, Rodent Killers



Workbench

Stains, Varnishes, Solvents, Degreasers, Rust Removers, Paint Thinners, Oil Based Paints, Wood Preservatives

**The Transfer Station accepts syringes from residents in approved containers. No sticker is required.

***Prescription medication may be disposed of safely at the Lakeville Police Station.
