

**SPECIAL TOWN ELECTION
November 5, 2019**

The Special Election of the Town of Lakeville was held at the Ted Williams Camp, Loon Pond Lodge, 28 Precinct Street in accordance with the warrant issued by the Selectmen and properly posted by a constable of the Town.

Specimen ballots, penalty and instruction cards were posted in accordance with the law. The ballot boxes were inspected, found to be empty, and registers were set at zero and posted. All election officers were sworn to the faithful performance of their duties.


The polls were declared open at 12:00 PM and closed at 8:00 PM in accordance with the Warrant. There were **1,192 ballots cast, including 58** absentees. Precinct One had 296 ballots, Precinct Two had 525 ballots and Precinct Three had 371 ballots. Preliminary totals were announced, and then all ballots were checked for write-ins. The final results are as follows:
