

SPECIAL TOWN ELECTION

September 10, 2019

A Special Election of the Town of Lakeville was held at the Ted Williams Camp, Loon Pond Lodge, 28 Precinct Street in accordance with the warrant issued by the Selectmen and properly posted by a constable of the Town.

Specimen ballots, penalty and instruction cards were posted in accordance with the law. The ballot boxes were inspected, found to be empty, and registers were set at zero. All election officers were sworn to the faithful performance of their duties.

The polls were declared open at 12:00 PM and closed at 8:00 P.M. in accordance with the Warrant. There were **746 ballots cast**, including 15 absentees. Precinct One had 195, Precinct Two had 286 and Precinct Three had 265 Preliminary totals were announced about 8:10 P.M. by the Town Clerk and they were as follows:

Question: Shall the Town of Lakeville be allowed to exempt from the provisions of proposition two and one-half, so-called, the amounts required to pay for the bond issued in order to fund the construction, maintenance, improvement, repair, replacement and/or relocation of rights of way, sidewalks, drainage, utilities, driveways, retaining walls, guardrails, slopes, grading, rounding, construction, landscaping, and other appurtenances and/or facilities, to enable the Town to undertake the Route 79 (Myricks St./Rhode Island Road) rehabilitation project and any and all costs incidental or related thereto; and to reconstruct, resurface and repair Town roads, including the payment of all costs incidental or related thereto?
